

ARIA/Hagen Family Foundation Travel Award

Applications are now being accepted for the 2010 ARIA/Hagen Family Foundation Travel Award. Awards of up to \$1,500.00 each will be granted to faculty and/or doctoral students who attend and present a paper at the 2nd World Risk and Insurance Economics Congress.

The objective of the award is “to extend the opportunity to attend the ARIA meeting to those who would not otherwise attend, yet would benefit from the interaction with their peers.”

To be eligible for a travel award, an applicant must:

- be a faculty member or Ph.D. student from a U.S. or foreign university
- have a research presentation accepted for the 2010 ARIA meeting program
- indicate a lack of funding from their institution for the purpose of attending the ARIA meeting

Applicant's papers will be reviewed by the ARIA program committee and if accepted, the application will be evaluated by the Hagen Family Foundation Travel Award Committee. Priority will be given to applicants who have not received funding from this award in the previous three years. If more than one paper is deemed eligible for consideration, then the selection decision will be based on the merits of the papers and the financial need of the applicant.
