Executive summaries (not exceeding three pages) that focus on the purpose, expected results, and importance of the research may be submitted. Completed papers are preferred. Proposals from doctoral students are encouraged. Submitted papers should not have been accepted for publication.

The deadline for submission is **February 20, 2018**. This deadline will not be extended. **Proposals must be submitted electronically using the link below in Acrobat (pdf) format.** **Please remove all author information from your paper (double-blind review process)**
