The journal welcomes theoretical or applied research papers on risk, insurance, or actuarial topics, including insurance pricing, law and regulation/supervision, insurance economics and finance, insurance practice and policy, social insurance, employee benefits, pension, risk management, international insurance issue and insurance education. Papers dealing with financial planning and other insurance-related areas are also welcome.

All papers submitted for publication in APJRI must have not been published in any other journals. Each paper must contain an abstract and complete information about the author(s) including postal and e-mail addresses. Only electronic file in MS Word, either by e-mail attachment or on diskette, will be accepted. Each paper is subject to double blind peer review at the discretion of the editors. This review process usually takes six to eight weeks.
