This position is full-time, tenure-track, and requires teaching two courses per regular semester in actuarial science. Research in actuarial science is expected. Salary is competitive and dependent upon qualifications and experience. NIU is a research university. The faculty of the division are active in research and in supervising PhD students, and currently have research grants from the Society of Actuaries (SOA) and multiple federal agencies. Qualifications

Applicants must have completed all requirements of a PhD in actuarial science or a related field prior to August 16, 2012 and show promise for excellence in both teaching and research. Must have passed at least two of the preliminary examinations of the SOA / CAS, or the equivalents of other societies. Continued interest in becoming a Fellow of a professional actuarial society is required as well. Associateship or Fellowship in a professional actuarial society, experience as an academic advisor and/or actuarial program coordinator, and industrial experience are all preferred.
