Applications are invited for a tenure-track position in the Warren Centre for Actuarial Studies and Research in the I.H. Asper School of Business at the University of Manitoba. The appointment will be at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor. The appointment start date is July 1, 2012, or soon thereafter.

The University of Manitoba has been offering actuarial courses since 1912, making it one of the oldest centres of actuarial education in North America. Over 800 graduates have become either Associates or Fellows of the Society of Actuaries or Casualty Actuarial Society. The Warren Centre offers undergraduate programs leading to either a B.Comm (Hons) or B.Sc. (Hons) degree, with preparation for professional examinations.

Candidates for this position must have a demonstrated interest and experience with actuarial education and research. Candidates must have completed or have nearly completed a Ph.D. in Actuarial Science, Mathematics, Statistics, Finance, or a related field. Candidates should be enthusiastic about teaching talented undergraduate and graduate students and helping them prepare for actuarial careers. Duties include research in actuarial science, teaching a range of actuarial courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels, and professional service for the School, the University, and the community. Salary is competitive and will depend on qualifications and experience.

The I. H. Asper School of Business is the principal business school in the province of Manitoba and is accredited by AACSB. The School offers undergraduate, MBA, M.Sc. and PhD degrees. The Asper School is a research intensive institution comprised of approximately 55 full-time faculty members publishing in leading academic journals. Substantial research funding is provided for new faculty members as is a fully paid six month sabbatical after three years. The School is located in a modern facility overlooking the Red River.
