A PhD with research accomplishments and/or industry experience in actuarial science/risk management required. Must be an Associate or Fellow of the CAS or SOA. Initial duties will include preparing an Enterprise Risk Management Course at the graduate level and teaching courses required for the Chartered Enterprise Risk Analyst (CERA) Credential at the undergraduate level. Preference will be given to candidates with commendable teaching experience at the university level, relevant and significant business experience, and/or an established publication record.

Compensation:

Salary is competitive with peer AACSB schools and dependent on qualifications and experience.
