

Eastern Kentucky University invites applications for the position of a tenure track, Associate Professor/Professor of Insurance Position in the Department of Accounting, Finance, and Information Systems located within the College of Business and Technology. The successful candidate is expected to provide visionary leadership and direction to the Insurance Program, the only such program within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The successful candidate must demonstrate a strong record of excellence in teaching, research and service commensurate with AACSB International standards. The incumbent will teach undergraduate and graduate courses in the areas of insurance and risk management; work with faculty to develop appropriate curricula; recruit and advise students; and foster positive relations with insurance and risk management alumni and professionals within the state, region, and nation. In addition, the successful candidate will demonstrate leadership skills in building cooperative and collaborative relationships both with the University's and College's other academic units and with appropriate private and public insurance and risk management entities external to the University.

Applicants must hold a doctorate in an appropriate field from a regionally accredited institution as well as a distinguished record of research and teaching in the area of insurance and risk management.
