The School of Business Administration at The University of Mississippi invites applications for a tenure-track position at either the assistant or the associate professor level for Fall, 2011. To be considered for this position, the applicant must have a doctorate degree from an AACSB accredited or well regarded business program in Risk Management and Insurance (RMI) or Finance by August, 2011, and have demonstrated research and teaching interests in RMI). The candidate must also provide evidence of excellent teaching skills and the ability to conduct research aimed toward top-tier journals. Teaching needs are primarily upper-level undergraduate with a normal teaching load of two courses per semester. An active research agenda, teaching proficiency, and some service related to the RMI industry are expected.

The RMI program is part of the Department of Finance in the School of Business Administration. This position is partially supported by the Liberto-King Professorship of Insurance endowment.
