Applicants are invited to apply for the position of Research Fellow (Actuarial Studies) in the Centre of Excellence in Population Ageing Research, Australian School of Business, UNSW. The ARC Centre for Excellence in Population Ageing Research offers exceptional opportunities for suitably qualified applicants to join a multi-disciplinary research team committed to transforming thinking about population ageing and establishing Australia as a world leader in the field.

This position will perform research in the Centre of Excellence in Population Ageing Research on actuarial and risk management aspects of population ageing under the supervision of Professor Michael Sherris. The research will address advanced risk modelling and risk management aspects of population ageing including financial, risk management and policy issues around longevity and morbidity models and product solutions including health and life insurance and involve interaction with economists, demographers and sociologists.

This is a full time, fixed term appointment for up to three (3) years.

Applicants for the positions should hold a PhD in risk management or actuarial studies, or a relevant discipline such as mathematical statistics, economics, or quantitative finance, or an equivalent qualification. Successful candidates will have an outstanding performance in research in a field relevant to the project. Applicants should have excellent communication skills.
