



The **Faculty of Mathematics and Economics** at the University of Ulm in Germany invites applications for a **Junior Professorship in Actuarial Mathematics** (pay scale W1) to commence **as soon as possible**.

We invite applications by mathematicians (also with a background in financial mathematics or stochastics/statistics) as well as quantitatively oriented economists (e.g. with a background in insurance economics, health economics, risk management) or researchers in related fields with an interest in actuarial research. The Junior Professor is expected to help increase the range of actuarial courses offered by our Faculty. The Junior Professorship will be supported by the Signal-Iduna-Versicherungsgruppe. Hence we seek a candidate, who is open to practical problems and applications as well as to cooperation with companies. The Junior Professorship will be part of the Institute of Insurance Sciences, an internationally linked center of research and teaching in actuarial sciences, risk management and insurance, which offers an attractive research-oriented environment.

The selection and employment procedure is based on the regulations laid down by university law regarding the appointment of professors. Employment conditions require a university degree, educational qualification which is normally proven by teaching experience, and qualification for academical working which is normally proven by an outstanding doctorate.

The professorship is initially limited to three years. Depending on a positive evaluation, the position will be extended for another three years. There will be no further extension.

The University of Ulm is committed to increase the share of women in research and teaching positions and therefore explicitly encourages female candidates to apply.
