**Position:** One tenure track position in finance, risk management and insurance at the Assistant/Associate Professor rank.

**Required Qualifications:** Candidates must have a doctoral degree in Finance, Financial Economics or Risk Management and Insurance from an AACSB accredited (or equivalent) university, and evidence of successful, high quality research in the risk management and insurance area. Candidates without a completed doctoral degree (ABD) will not be considered. Selected candidates will be required to teach risk management and insurance courses at the undergraduate and graduate level, and candidates with such experience will be strongly preferred.

**Finance Program:** In 2010, the Business School received a gift of \$5,000,000 to set up a *Risk Management and Insurance (RMI) Program* within the Finance group. This is the only RMI program in the entire Rocky Mountain region and the Mountain West, and has tremendous opportunities for growth, with financial backing from the pledged gift. The Finance Program offers (i) MS in Finance (ii) MBA with finance concentrations (iii) MBA with Risk Management and Insurance concentration (iv) BSBA with (a) finance area of emphasis (b) RMI concentration anchored in finance (c) financial management area of emphasis. It will offer a graduate program in Risk Management soon.

**Job Responsibility:** The position is 40% research, 40% teaching, and 20% service. The person to be hired is expected to be active in the conceptualization and implementation of a high quality graduate RMI program, and work in partnership with the RMI industry to accomplish this goal.

**The School:** The Business School is AACSB accredited, and has the largest graduate business program in the region, with about 1200 MBA and MS students, in addition to 1200 undergraduate students. To support faculty research and instruction, the school subscribes to WRDS, CRSP, COMPUSTAT, SNL, and Bloomberg Information System. The normal teaching load is 4 semester long courses (each 3 hours per week) during a 9 month contract.

**The University:** University of Colorado Denver is an urban campus located in the heart of the city's commercial, cultural and recreational district and has positioned itself to be one of the top urban research universities in the country. UCD was recently rated by *Forbes* as one of the top 50 public universities in the nation.
